Join us for a public meeting to review the potential improvements to the Las Olas Boulevard Corridor between Andrews Avenue and S.E. 11th Avenue, including:

- Improvements to sidewalk curbs/ramps to meet American with Disabilities Act standards
- Addition of a parallel bike route
- Pedestrian lighting
- High emphasis pedestrian crosswalks
- Sidewalk improvements
- Landscaping

A brief presentation on the project background and design alternatives will begin at 6:00 p.m. Guests will then be invited to join small groups to review design alternatives and share comments. Project team members will be available to answer any questions participants may have.
