This project was implemented to improve safety for people walking, biking, and driving on Las Olas Boulevard and in the surrounding neighborhood. Project improvements include:

- Increasing traffic capacity and pedestrian safety on S.E. 15th Avenue between Broward Boulevard and Las Olas Boulevard.
- Reducing cut-through traffic in the Colee Hammock neighborhood by introducing traffic calming measures.
- A six-month safety improvements demonstration for people walking, biking, and driving on Las Olas Boulevard.

Guests are encouraged to walk, bike, carpool, or use a rideshare service to attend the event.



Las Olas Boulevard will be temporarily closed between S.E. 6th and S.E. 11th Avenue for the 30th Annual Las Olas Art Fair.
