COUNT I

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT ON A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, TO ALL AND SINGULAR THE
SHERIFFS AND CONSTABLES OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, Detective Orlando F. Almanzar, of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department has this day made oath before me that on the 28 day of November, A.D. 2016, in the County aforesaid, one Tavares Traevon Taylor did then and there intentionally and unlawfully threaten by word or act to do violence to the person of Detective Vincent Falzone, of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department, coupled with an apparent ability to do so, knowing at the time that Vincent Falzone was a law enforcement officer engaged in the lawful performance of his duties, and did an act, to-wit: intentionally and purposely driving a stolen vehicle towards Detective Vincent Falzone, which created a well-founded fear in Detective Vincent Falzone that violence was imminent, and said assault was committed with a deadly weapon, more particularly described as 2012 Ford Fusion, without intent to kill, contrary to F.S. 784.011, F.S. 784.021 and F.S. 784.07(2)(c), (L6).

The offense(s) set forth in the foregoing Warrant is/are contrary to the statute(s) in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida. Attached hereto and made a part hereof by incorporation is the Affidavit executed by Detective Orlando F. Almanzar, Affiant herein.

THESE ARE, THEREFORE, to command you forthwith to arrest the said Tavares Traevon Taylor, and bring him/her before me to be dealt with according to law.

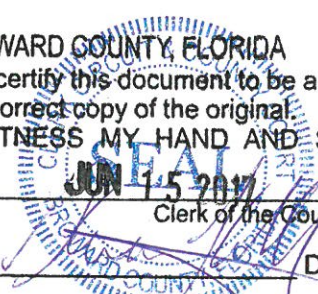

BEFORE ME, Raag Singhal Judge of the Circuit Court in and for Broward County, came Detective Orlando Almanzar, who has presented via electronic means pursuant to F.S. 933.07, after being duly sworn, deposes and says that on the 28 day of November, A.D. 2016 in the County and State aforesaid, one TAVARES TRAEVON TAYLOR B/M DOB 05/15/96 SSN [REDACTED] did then and there intentionally and purposely drive a stolen vehicle towards Fort Lauderdale Police Detective Vincent Falzone, which created a well-founded fear in Detective Vincent Falzone that violence was imminent.

On November 28, 2016, at approximately 12:21 PM Fort Lauderdale Police Detectives Vincent Falzone and Jonathan Jones were patrolling in an unmarked vehicle when they spotted a stolen Gray Ford Fusion. The plain clothes detectives followed the vehicle to the McDonalds parking lot located at 2401 W. Sunrise Blvd. The stolen Ford Fusion with Maine tag 932-6UG was taken on 11/01/16 from 1301 Belvedere Rd. West Palm Beach FL 33401 Palm Beach Police Department case number 2016-0019658. The stolen vehicle which was occupied by three individuals entered the McDonald's drive thru lane. Detective Jones informed the rest of their team via police radio. Detective Guerra/1769, who was staging across the street, drove his unmarked vehicle in the opposite direction of the drive thru lane and stopped in front of the stolen vehicle. Detectives Jones and Falzone followed in their own unmarked vehicle and stopped behind Detective Guerra's vehicle.

The emergency red and blue lights were activated on both Detective vehicles. The three Detectives approach the occupants of the stolen vehicle on foot. Detective Guerra and Falzone who were driving their respective unmarked police vehicles approached the passenger side.

Detective Jones who was the passenger in his vehicles remained in the driver's side of the stolen vehicle. Your Honor should be aware that all plain clothes detectives were wearing their body armor consisting of a black tactical vests with the word "Police" displayed in the front and back of their vest.

As the Detectives approached the front passenger later identified as B/M Deontc Delisser exited the vehicle and fled on foot. Detective Guerra pursued him while Detective Falzone continued walking towards the stolen vehicle. Delisser discarded a handgun as he fled but he was apprehended shortly afterwards.

At the same time Delisser fled from the stolen vehicle the driver backed up, however, there was another customer vehicle behind him. The driver then drove aggressively forward, directly towards Detective Falzone and struck him in the left knee. Detective Falzone had to jump on the hood of Detective Guerra's vehicle to avoid being ran over. The suspect then turned right to avoid colliding with the unmarked police vehicle. The stolen vehicle went over the drive-thru curve, through some bushes, over the sidewalk and onto Sunrise Blvd. The driver of the stolen Ford Fusion drove WB on the EB lanes until he reached the intersection of W. Sunrise Blvd. and NW 24th Ave. The incident was captured on video from the McDonald's surveillance system.

When the driver of the stolen vehicle drove forward towards Detective Falzone he was in fear for his life and discharged his handgun. Detective Jones also discharged his handgun; both detectives fired a total of four rounds at the stolen vehicle. The driver and only occupant of the stolen vehicle managed to get away but abandoned it a mile away in the 2800 block of NW 15th Court. In the rear passenger floor board, behind the driver's chair there was also a handgun. The vehicle was photographed on scene and towed to the FLPD.

Detective Breen, on 11/28/16 met with the owner of stolen Ford Fusion, Ashton Benn, and took a sworn audio recorded statement. Benn also consented to a search of his vehicle and signed a form giving FLPD detectives permission for the search. CSI Detective Johnson processed the stolen vehicle and collected all the evidence.


Given the lack of large amounts of blood in the car it is most unlikely the driver was struck by any of the Detectives bullets. However, the driver's side window was struck by the bullets and shattered, propelling shards of glass inwards. These shards of glass appear to have

caused a small laceration to the driver. There was a small speck of blood visible on the inside panel of the driver's door. The collected blood was sent to the crime lab and has been identified as blood / through the Florida DNA database as: this defendant TAVARES T. TAYLOR.

The defendant will be charged with the offence set forth in the foregoing Affidavit is/are contrary to the statute(s) 784.07-2c **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT ON AN OFFICER**; a second-degree felony in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.



On Monday, July 15, 2013 at 0945hrs. I responded to the T-Mobil located at 881 E Commercial Blvd in reference to a silent hold up alarm. While enroute I was advised by dispatch that they also received a call that there was a robbery in progress at the T-Mobil.

I arrived on scene along with Sgt Doriot. I came from the rear of the business as he approached from the front. Contact was made with the employees. They stated that two unknown black males entered the store armed with semi auto handguns. They took approximately 50 Galaxy Cellphones and fled east from the store on foot.

I then spoke individually with W/M, David Santos, DOB 11-02-82. He worked at T-Mobil as a sales associate. He stated that on this date at around 0940hrs. He was working behind the counter. He observed two black males enter the front door dressed all in black, with black ski masks covering their faces. One suspect pointed a black semi auto handgun at him and ordered him to the ground.

Santos went on to state that as he was going to the ground he triggered the silent hold up alarm. He was on the ground for a short period of time and was then ordered into the backroom. He was again ordered to the ground. The suspects took cellphones from the rear inventory room. He heard them ask where the back door was. They were informed that there was no back door. At that time both suspects ran out the front door.

I then spoke with B/F Gene Decious, DOB 08-04-86. She stated that she was also working behind the counter. She observed two black males enter through the front door wearing dark clothing and ski masks. One subject pointed a handgun at her and ordered her to the backroom. Once in the backroom she observed the suspects have the manager open the inventory room. She stood in the room as the suspects began removing the phones. Decious went on to state that the suspects were speaking to each other in Creole.

Decious stated that she also spoke Creole and new what the suspects were saying. She stated that on subject kept telling the other to "Hurry, Hurry" and also to get the Galaxy's. Decious finally stated that the suspects took the phones and ran out the front door. She saw them turn East towards the corner of the building.

Next I spoke with the manager W/M, Jonathan Valence, DOB 07-27-82. He stated that he was working in the backroom when the suspects came in. He observed two black male suspects dressed in black, with ski masks on, walking his employees into the back room. They pointed a gun at him and told him to open the inventory room. He went on to state that he complied and was then ordered to the ground. They took approximately 40-50 Galaxy phones worth around \$600 each and ran out the front door.

Finally I spoke with the witness W/F, Monique Burr, DOB 06-10-82. She stated that she was pulling into the parking lot. She observed two black males walking from the back of the shopping center towards the entrance to T-Mobil. Burr went on to state that the subjects were wearing what appeared to be black hoodies and skull caps on their heads.

Burr then stated that she saw both suspects pull the caps they were wearing down concealing their faces. They both then quickly walked in to the T-Mobil. Burr continued to state that she believed the suspects must have parked a vehicle to the rear of the store. She called 911 and then drove to the rear of the store. She

found that there was a white vehicle and a small silver vehicle parked in the rear of the store. She drove back to the front and saw a female employee of T-Mobil outside on the phone. She immediately drove back to the rear of the business and found that the silver vehicle was gone. She finally stated that she believed the silver vehicle was the suspect's. Burr waited for deputies to arrive and told them what she had observed.

CSA Williams (10699) arrived and began processing the scene for finger prints. Detective's Rupp and Augusti arrived. They confirmed that a GPS tracking unit had been taken by the suspects. They coordinated with the T-Mobil Corporate Office to obtain the location of the phone. I was also informed that the store video could only be obtained by the Corporate Office. The Detectives were working to obtain still photos of the incident.

The detectives tracked the vehicle to a location in Deerfield Bch. Deputies on scene located a vehicle that matched the description but the vehicle was not located. The tracker then showed a steady location of 248 NE 40th Ct in Deerfield. The second location was close to where the vehicle was recovered. It was believed that the suspect's left the vehicle and walked to the residence on foot. A perimeter was established in the area. K-9 and the aviation unit responded to the scene and assisted in the search.

Detective Copley (9483) arrived and was briefed on the incident. He began speaking with the victims and the witness. He received still photos of the suspects that were e-Mailed to the store from the corporate office.

Two suspects were detained at 248 NE 40th Ct. Det Copley transported Burr to the area for a show up. I was later advised that two subjects were transported to the Public Safety Building from the location in Pompano. I was finally advised that the detectives were obtaining a search warrant for the residence.

Deputy Rivera obtained the information of the subjects that were detained (see supplement).

I remained on scene and attempted to get an exact list of the phones that were taken. Valence provided me with a list of the number and types of phones that had been taken. He was unable to provide a list with each individual phone and serial number listed. The list he provided was as follows:

On 07/15/2013, at approximately 0947hrs I and Detective Rupp (CCN #10372) responded to the T-Mobile store located at 881 E Commercial Blvd, Oakland Park, FL, in reference to an armed robbery that just occurred. Upon arrival, Detective Rupp met with the store manager John Valence, who was on the phone with Kelly Jones, T-Mobile Loss Prevention. Detective Rupp then began speaking to Jones, who provided Detective Rupp with location information for one of the phones via GPS. As Detective Rupp relayed the location information to dispatch, I interviewed Monique Burr, a witness.

Burr advised that she observed two black males, wearing black hoody style sweatshirts and black beanies, walking south through the alley directly east of the T-Mobile. Burr advised that she noticed the subjects because she found it odd that the subjects would be wearing long sleeve sweatshirts and beanies on a hot summer day. Burr continued watching the subjects who lowered the beanies around their faces prior to entering the T-Mobile. Once the subjects entered the store with "ski masks", Burr realized that the store was being robbed and she called the Sheriff's Office.

While on the phone with dispatch, Burr drove around to the rear of the T-Mobile, and she observed two cars parked in the rear alley. She described one of the vehicles as being a newer model, gray in color vehicle, with no tinted windows. Burr continued to drive around the store, and as she circled for a second time, she observed the same two subjects that robbed the store enter the gray vehicle. After entering the vehicle, the subjects fled the scene.

Burr described the subjects as being in their late teens to early twenties, approximately 5'7" to 5'9" tall. Burr also stated that she observed the subjects prior to the ski masks covering their faces, and that both subjects had short cropped hair. The subjects were also wearing dark colored, denim style pants. Burr also advised that one of the subjects was possibly wearing a white undershirt, as she observed it protruding from underneath the sweatshirt.

After interviewing Burr, I met with Detective Rupp, who was still on the phone with Jones. Jones advised Detective Rupp that the map portion of the GPS tracker froze, and that the updates she was getting only provided a latitude and longitude. Detective Rupp and I then entered the store and I accessed the manager's computer. As Jones provided Detective Rupp with the GPS coordinates, I inputted them into Google Maps and forwarded the location information to dispatch. At approximately 1207 hrs, Jones provide coordinates "26.280340" and "-80.121153", which came back to 248 NE 40th Ct, Pompano Beach, FL; this was the last location provided by Jones as the tracker did not move from it. Jones also provided the following information for the GPS device: IMEI #868487002007045, SIM #8901260561521811783F, and Phone #253-314-2620.

While Detective Rupp was on the phone with Jones, she emailed me several still images captured from the video surveillance. The still images were printed and provided to Detective Copley (CCN #9483). While at T-Mobile, Detective Rupp also spoke to Steve Pisciotta, from Remote Tracking Systems who sells the GPS device, who emailed me several images containing a map and the path the subjects took after they fled the store. The images from Pisciotta were also forwarded to Detective Copley. Pisciotta also confirmed that the GPS device was still located at 248 NE 40th Ct, Pompano Beach, FL. After the subjects were detained, Detective Rupp and I left the T-Mobile store. Detective Rupp and I later responded back to the T-Mobile store where we met Jones who provided a copy of the video surveillance footage. The video surveillance footage was forwarded to Detective Copley.

On 7/15/13, roughly 10:00 A.M., I heard Dist 12 Deputies speaking over my B.S.O. radio about an Armed Robbery which had just occurred. I then called BSO dispatch and inquired about the robbery. Dispatch advised that the T-Mobile located at 881 East Commercial Blvd Oakland Park had just been robbed.

Shortly after learning about the Armed Robbery, I responded to the T-Mobile. I met with numerous Dist 12 Deputies, Sgt Doriot, Det Rupp, and Det Dunn. They explained to me that two subjects had just entered the T-Mobile armed with handguns, and wearing masks over their faces. They stated the armed subjects took 3 T-Mobile employees to the rear of the store, took roughly 50-100 cell phones worth \$21,000 from the back of the business, and then fled the store. They stated one of the cell phone boxes had a GPS tracker in it. They stated the GPS tracker was heading up through Pompano and into Deerfield Bch. They also informed me that there was a witness, later identified as Monique Burr, who saw one of the subject's face, just before they entered the T-Mobile. I spoke with the victims briefly, and found out that none of them would be able to identify the subjects, as the subjects wore masks over their faces.

While at the T-Mobile, I spoke with witness, Monique Burr. Burr stated she was driving in her vehicle next to the T-Mobile when two black males walked by her. She stated the black males were wearing all black clothing and were heading into the T-Mobile. She stated she got a good look at one of the subject's face before they masked up and went into the T-Mobile. She stated as she was calling 911, she drove to the rear (north-side) of the business and noticed two vehicles. She stated she observed a silver vehicle and a white in color vehicle. As I was speaking with Burr, I was informed that the GPS tracker led deputies, and the Aviation Unit to the area of 248 NE 40 Ct Deerfield Bch. Deputies located 4 black males at this location. The four subjects: B/M Georges Richardson 3/05/92, B/M Tavares Taylor 5/15/96, B/M Isaiah Cherenfant 8/30/96, and Denzel LaFrance 11/03/96 were all detained

I then drove Burr to 248 NE 40 Ct Deerfield. At approximately 11:27 A.M., Burr positively identified (100%) subject, Isaiah Cherenfant, as the subject who she witnessed walk past her and into the T-Mobile. She stated he was one of the Armed Robbery subjects. All four subjects were then brought into the Public Safety Building.

At 11:48 A.M. I took a taped statement from Burr. She again went over the fact that she saw two subjects walk past her and into the T-Mobile. She stated one of the subjects looked her right in the eyes before they walked into the T-Mobile and masked-up. She stated she was absolutely 100% positive that Isaiah Cherenfant was the subject who looked her right in the eyes before he walked into the T-Mobile. See Burr's transcribed statement for details.

After taking Burr's statement, I responded into the Public Safety Building.

While at the Public Safety Building, I made sure that all 4 subjects were separated. I requested that Det Woulard assist me with the interviews.

At 1:35 P.M. Det Woulard and I brought Taylor into a video recorded interview room. Post Miranda, Taylor confessed in detail that he and the other 3 subjects were all involved in this T-Mobile Armed Robbery. He stated he and the other three subjects planned this Armed Robbery at the T-Mobile for the past two days. He stated he drove the subjects in a white Chevy Impala to a silver BMW where subjects (Cherenfant and LaFrance) got into. All four subjects then drove to the T-Mobile in both vehicles. Taylor stated while at the T-Mobile, (Cherenfant and LaFrance), got out,

wearing dark hooded sweatshirts, masks, and armed with handguns. Taylor, stated he and Richardson acted as lookouts while Cherenfant and LaFrance went in the business and committed the Armed Robbery. After committing the Armed Robbery, all four subjects left the crime scene in both the white Chevy Impala and the silver BMW. Taylor also mentioned that subject Richardson walked into the Dunkin Donuts just before they robbed the T-Mobile. He stated the Dunkin Donuts is located next to the T-Mobile. Taylor also mentioned where the BMW, that they used to commit the Armed Robbery, would be located

At 2:47 P.M. Det Woulard and I brought Denzel LaFrance into a video recorded interview room. Post Miranda, LaFrance denied any involvement in the Armed Robbery.

After interviewing Taylor and LaFrance separately, we placed them together in the same interview room. (15:58:30) on the video, Taylor tells LaFrance "when you went in". (16:02:45) LaFrance tells Taylor "I told them I knew you from school and hadn't dealt with you since then". (16:04:35) Taylor states to LaFrance; "they showed me pictures when you have the gun, and the guy crouches". (16:52:40) Taylor asks how many phones they got, LaFrance answers "about 50". (16:54:22) LaFrance mentions something about him with a mask. (17:20:23) LaFrance states something to the effect: they never saw my face, the man had his head in the computer by the time I ran through the door. LaFrance then acts out as if placing a mask down over his face. He also acts out as if he is reaching for a handgun. See the video for details.

At 4:03 P.M. Det Woulard and I placed Cherenfant into a video recorded interview room. Post Miranda, Cherenfant denied any involvement in the T-Mobile Armed Robbery. See the video for details.

After speaking with Cherenfant, we placed Taylor and LaFrance in the same interview room with him. (17:17:15) on the video LaFrance tells the other two "I know we can beat this, we were masked up". See the video for details.

At 5:45 P.M. I placed Georges Richardson into a video recorded interview room. Richardson invoked his rights.

While interviewing all 4 subjects, Deputies located both the white in color Chevy Impala Fl tag BXA K60 (parked at 248 NE 40 Ct Deerfield), and the silver BMW Fl tag 881 TRX (parked at 3321 NE 1 Ave Pompano). These were the two vehicles that Taylor stated were used to commit the Armed Robbery. Located inside the BMW and in plain-view were hooded jackets and ski masks. Both vehicles were towed to Emerald Towing.

After interviewing everyone, I typed up probable cause affidavits on all 4 subjects while Det Woulard obtained and executed a search warrant at 248 NE 40 Ct Deerfield Bch. Located at the residence, just like Taylor stated, were 36 cell phones which were confirmed to be the T-Mobile cell phones taken during the Armed Robbery, and a H&K 45 caliber handgun. The evidence was photographed and collected as evidence.

On 7/16/13, I typed up a Search Warrant for the silver BMW. Crime Scene Det. Caperton and I executed the warrant the same evening. Located inside the BMW were two ski masks, and two dark sweatshirts. Latent fingerprints and DNA were also recovered from within the vehicle.

On 7/17/13, I responded to the Dunkin Donuts located at 801 East Commercial Blvd Oakland Park Fl. I spoke with the store manager and requested the video from 7/15/13 the time frame of the Armed Robbery. On 7/19/13, I was given a

C.D. from the Dunkin Donuts' video surveillance cameras. I brought the video to BSO's Technical Support Unit. On 7/15/13 at 9:35 A.M. Georges Richardson is seen on video inside the Dunkin Donuts. It should be noted that this is just before the Armed Robbery at the T-Mobile. See the C.D. and still photos for details.

On 7/19/13, I responded to the T-Mobile. I met with the 3 T-Mobile employees who were robbed at gunpoint. The employees: David Santos, Gene Decius, and Janathan Valence provided taped statements. All 3 victims stated they were inside the T-Mobile the morning of 7/15/13, when two subjects burst through the front door masked up and armed with handguns. They stated they were ordered to the rear of the business where the subjects then took a total of 36 cell phones worth \$21,000. All 3 victims stated they were in fear for their lives and wished to prosecute. See the 3 victim statements for details.

On 8/02/13, the felony packet for this case was sent to the Juvenile Division.

On Sunday, March 26th, 2017 at 6:00 am, agents with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office -South Florida Task Force (SFTF) conducted stationary surveillance on a stolen 2008 Silver Chevy Impala bearing Florida tag HKFM89 documented under WPBPD case #16-23471 (hereinafter referred to as suspect vehicle). The suspect vehicle had been identified by the West Palm Beach Police Department (WPBPD) as being involved in overnight vehicle burglaries throughout Palm Beach County (verified suspect vehicle in WPBPD case #17-0005711). A WPBPD Patrol Officer located the suspect vehicle at 5101 Caribbean Blvd, West Palm Beach, Florida (Saddlebrook Apartments). At approximately 12:30 pm, agents followed the stolen Impala where it was observed parking at the Food Town Super Market Palm Beach located at 5335 North Military Trail, West Palm Beach, Florida. Due to heavy amount of traffic and distance, agents were unable to see how many occupants exited the suspect vehicle. Agents set up surveillance in the parking lot around the suspect vehicle. I, Agent Cano, parked my PBSO unmarked vehicle directly behind the stolen Impala one row to the West.

Approximately fifteen minutes later, I observed two black males exit the China Man Photo Store and enter the suspect vehicle. Agents executed a tactical vehicle suppression maneuver on the suspect vehicle in an attempt to take both subjects into custody. The unmarked PBSO vehicles activated our red and blue emergency lights at the time of the vehicle suppression. Once the suspect vehicle was "contained" PBSO agents exited their unmarked vehicles and approached the suspect vehicle on foot. The agents gave loud verbal commands stating "PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, LET ME SEE YOUR HANDS". The agents were all wearing their issued ballistic vests with "SHERIFF" clearly marked on the front and back. The driver of the vehicle, attempted to quickly exit the vehicle and flee from agents, but noticed Sergeant Spuck #5249 and his K-9 working dog just outside his door. The driver got back into the suspect vehicle and locked his driver side door. Agent Vera #9044 was positioned at the driver's side windshield and gave verbal instructions to the driver to show his hands. During this time the driver reached into his pants and retrieved the vehicle keys ignoring Agent Vera's commands. The driver then placed the keys in the ignition and started the engine. WPBPD Detective Flores #1898 (Detective Flores is assigned to the SFTF) was able to remove the passenger from the vehicle prior to the driver getting the vehicle started. Observing these actions Detective Flores also gave commands to the driver to place his hands up. In an effort to gain control of the subjects, Detective Flores extracted the passenger from the vehicle and placed him against the vehicle to be handcuffed. The passenger did not comply with Detective Flores' commands to place his hands behind his back. This resulted in the passenger being moved to the ground for handcuffing purposes. The driver at this point had the vehicle started and placed the vehicle into gear in an effort to flee. Due to the driver not complying with commands and the suspect vehicle having dark tinted windows which obstructed agents' view of the vehicle's interior, I utilized an impact tool to break the rear passenger side window of the suspect vehicle. This enabled agents to see inside the suspect vehicle and potentially allow us to unlock the driver side door. Agent Vera, who was still at the driver's side windshield, began striking the windshield with his fist as a distraction technique to gain the driver's attention. Agent Vera continued to give loud verbal commands to the driver to place his hands on the dashboard. The driver did not obey any of Agent Vera's commands and the driver began manipulating the car forward and backward thus striking the PBSO unmarked vehicles parked behind and in front of the suspect vehicle. The driver did this several times until he had created enough space between the vehicles that he could maneuver his car out of the

containment position. As a result of the driver's actions Agent Vera was struck by the vehicle (front quarter panel) and pushed several feet away. Additionally after striking the windshield with his left hand, Agent Vera sustained lacerations and embedded glass fragments in his left forearm, palm and fingers. The other agents within close proximity to the fleeing suspect vehicle also had to move out of the way while the driver operated the vehicle in this reckless and violent manner. Detective Flores had to pull the passenger away from the vehicle to keep him from being struck by the fleeing driver/vehicle. While fleeing the Food Town Super Market Palm Beach the suspect driver nearly struck multiple pedestrians and vehicles in the parking lot. These bystanders and motorists had to evasively move out of the way to avoid being struck by the suspect vehicle. The vehicle then sped out of the parking lot and onto Military Trail, southbound at a high rate of speed.

The PBSO Aviation Unit was on scene during the course of the above incident. The aviation unit continued to conduct video recorded, aerial surveillance and advised SFTF Agents via radio of the suspect vehicle's location. After traveling approximately two miles on different roadways, The aviation unit observed the driver enter Royal Poinciana Place Apartments located at 5500 Haverhill Road N, West Palm Beach, Florida. The driver exited the suspect vehicle and fled, on foot into an unknown apartment located on the west side of the apartment complex.

Detective Flores identified the passenger as Richard Allen Evans Jr. Evans advised on scene that he did not know who the driver was and he was only getting a ride home from him. Evans stated that he ran into the suspect driver at the Chinaman Photo Store and while inside the store, Evans asked the suspect driver for a ride. Evans was not aware the suspect vehicle was stolen. After further investigation, no probable cause was established to arrest Evans. Evans was released from the scene without injury or incident. It should be noted that Evans was carrying small black back pack in his left hand prior to entering the stolen vehicle. That black backpack was not found in the suspect vehicle after the driver bailed out of it and further review of the aviation video shows the driver running out the suspect vehicle with the backpack. It is unknown at this time what was in the backpack and who the backpack belonged to.

This entire event was captured and recorded on video surveillance by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, Aviation Unit.

The suspect vehicle was sealed off with evidence tape and towed by Sisters Towing to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office impound lot located at 3228 Gun Club Rd. West Palm Beach Florida 33406.

On Monday, March 27th, 2017 a vehicle search warrant was signed and approved by honorable Judge Sherri Collins (Warrant # PBSO_2017_000386) to process the suspect vehicle for DNA and latent prints in attempt to identify the suspect driver.

On Tuesday, March 28th, 2017 the aforementioned search warrant was executed on the vehicle. I discovered a strong odor of unburnt marijuana emanating from inside. Crime Scene Technician Zeilinski #7368 processed the vehicle for DNA and latent prints as requested in the original search warrant. Upon completion of that, in plain view I discovered marijuana residue and small clear plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana located on the driver side floorboard.

On Tuesday, March 28th, 2017 an additional vehicle search warrant was signed and approved by Honorable Judge Sherri Collins (PBSO_2017_000404) in attempt to search the suspect vehicle and its compartments for marijuana and/or drug paraphernalia. With the assistance of Crime Scene Technician Zelinski, sixteen (16) small blue clear plastic baggies with suspected marijuana were found inside a small orange Pringle box and five (5) small clear plastic baggies with suspected marijuana were found inside a large clear plastic bag located in the suspect vehicles center counsel. That suspected marijuana was field tested utilizing a Sirchie Field Test Kit which turned purple indicating positive for the presence of THC. Total packaged weight of the marijuana found in the suspect vehicle was 23 grams. All marijuana found within the vehicle was photographed by Crime Scene Technician Zelinski noting where it was located inside the vehicle. For details of Crime Scene Technician Zelinski's evidence processing, see his supplemental report.

All marijuana found within the vehicle, the stolen tag, the aviation video and the photos of the scene and Agent Vera's injuries were all placed into PBSO District 16 Evidence Room.

After executing both search warrants on the suspect vehicle, the PBSO impound lot personnel made contact with the registered owner in an effort to release the vehicle back to him. An Inventory and Return form was completed with all items recovered from the suspect vehicle listed on it. A copy of the form was given to the Clerk of Courts Office at PBSO HQ.

Detective Flores and I responded to the China Man Photo Store (located at 5335 N Military Trail, WPB FL). This is where I observed Evans and the suspect driver both exit from prior to entering the suspect vehicle on the day of the fleeing incident. Contact was made with store manager Anthony Bisham Jaipersaud. Anthony provided Detective Flores and I with surveillance video of Evans and the suspect driver inside the store. That surveillance video was later placed into PBSO District 16 Evidence Room.

On Monday, June 19, 2017, I received a Latent Report from PBSO Crime Line in reference to a latent finger print found on the Pringles chip container found in the center counsel as well as the rear view mirror of the of the suspect vehicle. PBSO Latent Examiner Cindy Riggsbee #2845 advised that a latent fingerprint match came back to Tavares Taylor (B/M DOB: 05/15/1996) State ID#07457296.

Utilizing the State of Florida, Driver and Vehicle Information Database (DAVID), I queried Tavares Taylor for his driver's license photo. Based on the driver's license photo and my interaction with him on the day of the incident, I positively identified Tavares Taylor as the driver of the suspect vehicle. Agent Vera #9044 was shown the same photo and positively identified Tavares Taylor as the driver of the suspect vehicle as well.



Before me this date personally appeared 11/29/2016 who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 28 day of Nov, 2016 at 2300 W Sunrise Blvd, Ft Lauderdale, Broward Co., FL (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

A traffic stop was conducted on a grey Ford Fusion (Maine Tag#93264G), which was previously stolen out of Palm Beach County, FL (Case#20160019658). Post Miranda, DEF admitted to being a passenger in the stolen vehicle, fleeing from police, and discarding a firearm.



On Tuesday 11/01/16 at about 0755 hours, I responded to the Holiday Inn parking lot (1301 Belvedere Rd), in reference to a delayed auto burglary. Upon my arrival, I met with the complainant/victim, Jonathan Bosque who informed me the following: While walking out to his vehicle (2016 white in color 4-door VW GTI, FL tag DGWU71) this morning, which he locked and parked yesterday in the west section of the hotel parking lot around 1720 hours. Bosque found the front right passenger window smashed in.

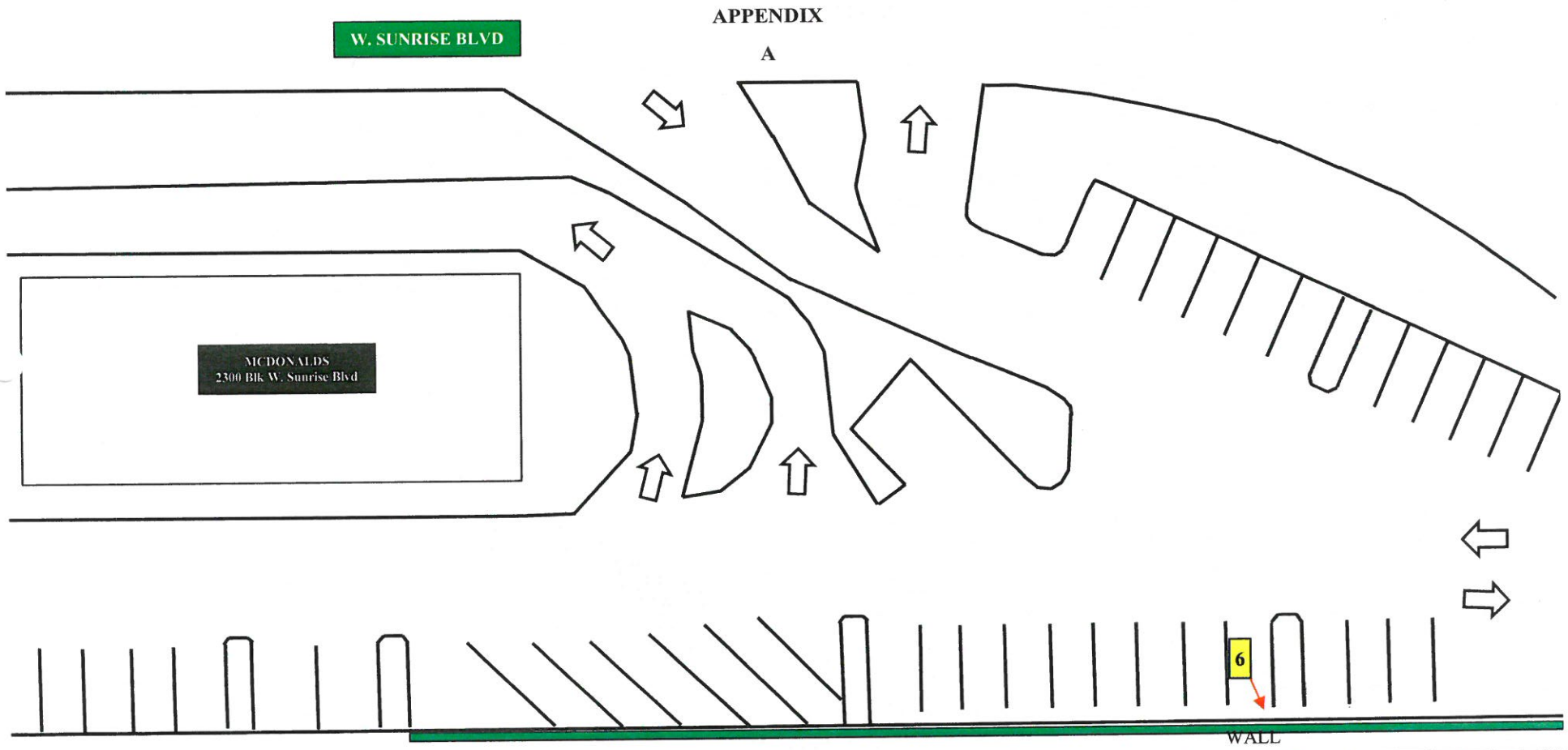

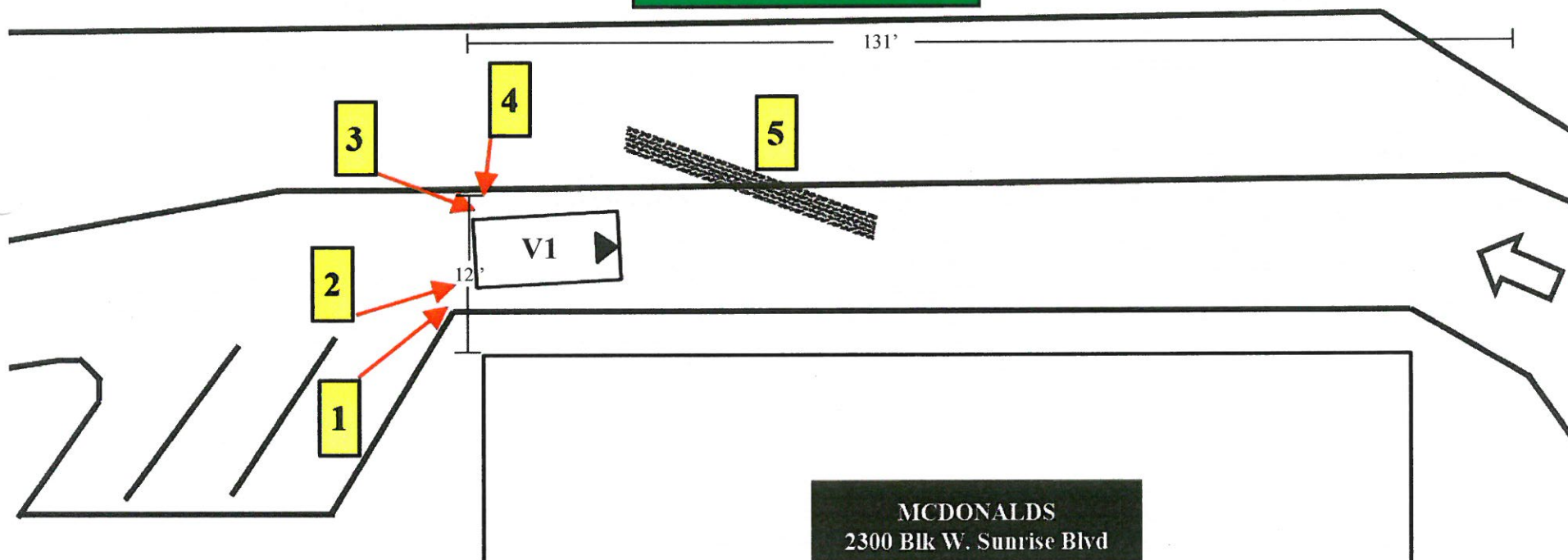

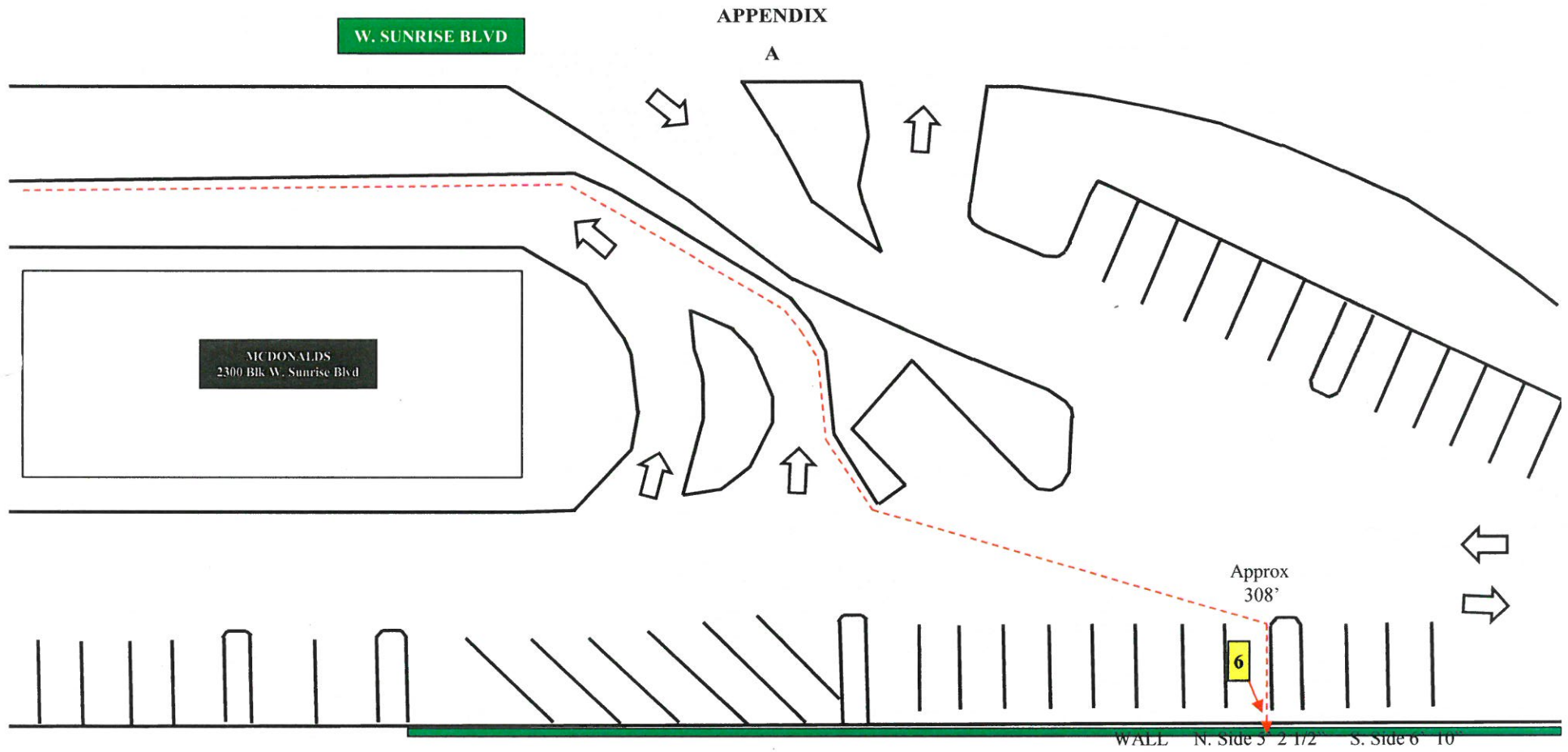

A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish and maintain guidelines for Fort Lauderdale Police Officers' Response to Resistance. All sworn members are issued copies of and instructed in the Response to Resistance Policy before they are authorized to carry a firearm, apprehend fleeing felons or placed into a position where they may utilize deadly force.

B. POLICY

1. It is the policy of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department that members shall only respond to the level of resistance necessary to effect lawful objectives. The response used by a member of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department must be objectively reasonable to meet the level of resistance. The following three factors are to be used to determine if the response level to resistance is objectively reasonable:
 - a. How serious is the suspected offense?
 - b. Is there a physical threat to the officer or anyone else?
 - c. Is the subject actively resisting or attempting to evade arrest by flight?
2. Fort Lauderdale Police Officers, or any person the officer has summoned or directed to assist, need not retreat or desist from efforts to make a lawful arrest because of resistance or threat of resistance to a lawful arrest. Members are justified in their response to resistance if that response is objectively reasonable to affect the lawful arrest or to defend the member or other persons from bodily harm.
3. This policy applies to the response to resistance of any nature whatsoever.
4. Any deviation from the provisions of this policy shall place a burden of justification on the member involved. Failure to meet this burden may result in disciplinary action, termination of employment and/or criminal charges.

C. DEFINITIONS

1. Felon - A person who the officer has probable cause to believe has committed, or is committing a crime that is punishable under Florida State law by death or imprisonment in excess of one year in a state penitentiary.
2. Forcible Felony – are the following classifications: treason, murder, manslaughter, sexual battery, car-jacking, home-invasion, robbery, burglary, arson, kidnapping, aggravated assault, aggravated battery, aggravated stalking, aircraft piracy, unlawful throwing, placing or discharging of a destructive device or bomb, and any other felony which involves the use or threat of physical force or violence against an individual.
3. Resistance – A subject’s attempt to prevent an officer from exercising control over him/her. Resistance can be non-verbal, verbal or physical in nature.
4. Compliance – is the verbal and/or physical yielding to an officer’s authority without apparent threat of resistance or violence.
5. Ability – The subject having the means to carry out his or her intent to cause death or great bodily harm.
6. Opportunity – The subject is capable of carrying out an intention to cause death or great bodily harm.
7. Intent – A reasonably perceived, imminent threat to an officer or another person based on the subject’s actions behaviors, words or other indicators. It is a perception derived from the totality of the circumstances.
8. Objective Reasonableness – The process for evaluating the appropriateness of an officer’s response to a subject’s resistance.
9. Probable Cause – Circumstances within one’s own knowledge and experience that is rational, trustworthy and supported by articulated facts to lead a responsible and prudent person to conclude that the information is true.
10. Totality of Circumstances – All facts and circumstance known to the officer at the time or reasonably perceived by the officer as the basis for a response to resistance decision.
11. Use of Force –A defensive or controlling response by an officer to overcome a person’s threatened or actual physical resistance to an officer’s performance of legal duty; to protect an officer or another person from physical resistance or acts of aggression that are likely to cause harm. This includes the use of deadly force.
12. Non-lethal Weapon – A weapon that is not fundamentally designed to cause death or great bodily harm.

13. Great Bodily Harm – A bodily injury that creates a substantial risk of death, serious permanent disfigurement, or long-term loss or impairment of the functioning of any bodily member or organ.
14. Non-Deadly Force – Any force not likely to cause death or great bodily harm.
15. Deadly Force - Any force which is likely to cause death or great bodily harm.

D. DEADLY FORCE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department places a greater value on the preservation of life than on the protection of property. It is in the best interest of the public, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department, and the officers of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department that the use of deadly force by the police balances the safety of the community and its police with the constitutional rights of the individual.

1. Officers use three criteria for making a decision to use deadly force: Ability, Opportunity and Intent. It is the policy of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department that officers are authorized to use deadly force when the officers have probable cause to believe that deadly force is required:

- a. To prevent death or great bodily harm to the officer or another person, or
- b. To prevent the imminent commission of a forcible felony where there is a risk of death or great bodily harm, or
- c. To prevent the escape of a fleeing felon whose actions provide probable cause for officers to believe that a suspect poses an immediate threat of death or great bodily harm to the officer or another person.

Several factors contribute to the determination that a fleeing felon would be an immediate threat of death or great bodily harm to the officer or another person. Such factors are limited to the officer's having a reasonable belief that:

- (1). The felon is armed and dangerous, or
- (2). The felon committed, or is committing, a felony where there is a risk of death or great bodily harm to the officer or another person.

2. Prohibited Actions


- a. It is prohibited to use deadly force when there is substantial risk to the safety of innocent bystanders who would be jeopardized by the officer's actions.
- b. Deadly force shall not be used against misdemeanants and traffic violators.

- c. Warning shots are prohibited.
 - d. Due to the inherent risk of causing death or serious and permanent brain damage the Lateral Vascular Neck Restraint (LVNR), (Sleeper Chokehold) is prohibited except in cases where it is reasonably necessary to prevent death or great bodily harm.
3. Shooting at or from moving vehicles or vessels:
- a. Officers shall not intentionally place themselves in the path of an oncoming vehicle or vessel (while on foot or in their police vehicle or vessel).
 - b. When confronting an oncoming vehicle or vessel, officers shall make every attempt to move out of the vehicle or vessel's path, rather than discharge their firearm or any other weapon at the oncoming vehicle or vessel.
 - c. Officers shall not discharge their firearm or any other weapon at or from a moving vehicle or vessel unless:
 - (1). Needed to prevent death or great bodily harm to an officer or another person.
 - (2). Needed to apprehend a person who just committed a felony resulting in death or great bodily harm.

Any deviation from this policy shall place a burden of justification on the member involved.

E. DRAWING FIREARMS

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department acknowledges the practical need for officers to unholster or draw their firearms in certain situations requiring caution for the officer's safety. In those situations requiring reasonable caution, in the absence of justification for the use of deadly force, the officer must be cognizant of the risks involved in drawing a firearm. All weapons shall be handled in a manner consistent with Department firearms training and safety procedures. When the handgun is used to cover a suspect or during a search for a suspect, the handgun will not be manually cocked. A firearm being pointed at a subject will require detailed documentation of an officer's actions in an Offense Report.

A. POLICY

It is the policy of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department that any response to resistance by Department members shall be accurately reported and subject to a thorough and objective evaluation.

B. FORCE CLASSIFICATIONS

1. Class 1 - Intentional use of deadly force. This includes:
 - a. Intentionally discharging a firearm, regardless of intent,
 - b. Intentional use of baton, motor vehicle, fists or other weapon, which results in great bodily harm.

Note: Any use of deadly force on an animal refer to policy 203.3, Animals (Use of Deadly Force)

2. Class 2 - Intentional use of non-deadly force is not likely to cause great bodily harm or death. This includes any use of baton, conducted energy device (Taser), fists, chemical munitions or any other non-lethal weapon which does or does not result in injury.

C. REPORTING METHOD

The following procedure applies anytime a response to resistance occurs, even if no arrest is made.

1. Class 1 - Intentional use of deadly force.

In the event an officer intentionally uses deadly force, the following procedure shall be adhered to:

 - a. The officer shall immediately summon and render first aid, and notify a supervisor of such response to resistance. The notified supervisor will respond and take charge of the scene.
 - b. The Shift/Duty Lieutenant shall ensure the following personnel are immediately notified:
 - (1). Chief of Police

- (2). Assistant Chiefs of Police
 - (3). Majors
 - (4). Internal Affairs Major
 - (5). Criminal Investigations Captain(s)
 - (6). Homicide Sergeant
 - (7). Legal Advisor
 - (8). Public Information Office
 - (9). Police Chaplain
 - (10). Support Services Facilities Captain
- c. The supervisor's responsibilities:
- (1). Ensure that necessary medical aid is provided to injured persons. Any Police Officer complaining of injury shall be sent to a medical facility for treatment as soon as possible and shall be accompanied by a member of the Department, unless the officer declines treatment.
 - (2). Secure the scene.
 - (3). Assign a member of the Department to:
 - (a). Maintain a log of persons entering or leaving the crime scene. Only persons, having an investigative purpose, shall enter the crime scene. Ideally, this should be limited to investigating and crime scene detectives.
 - (b). Detail the use of deadly force in an offense report and that a copy of the report is routed to Internal Affairs.
 - (4). Attempt to detain any persons considered to be possible witnesses. If unable to detain witnesses, attempt to obtain personal and/or vehicle identification.
- d. The Homicide Squad Supervisor shall be in overall command of the investigation.
- e. Police Officer(s) involved in the actual use of deadly force shall keep custody of their weapon(s) until ordered to surrender them to a Crime Scene Unit or Homicide Squad Detective. Weapons shall not be unloaded or otherwise tampered with prior to their surrender.

- f. Police Officer(s) involved should not be questioned by any member of the Department unless the "Miranda Warning" has been given and waived.
 - g. Police Officer(s) involved are to be removed from the scene as soon as possible at the direction of the Homicide Squad Supervisor.
 - h. Inquiries from non-police personnel, civilians, attorneys, news media, or family members of injured or deceased individuals shall be referred to the Public Information Office. Every effort will be made to provide the family members with information that will be contained in a press release prior to its dissemination to the media.
 - i. Any Police Officer handling evidence, entering the scene, or having or obtaining information relative to the investigation shall submit a police report forthwith. All reports will be delivered to the lead investigator of the Homicide Squad Shooting Team.
 - j. The lead detective of the Homicide Squad Shooting Team shall be responsible for conducting and coordinating the investigation. This detective shall be responsible for submitting a final report, via channels, for review by the Chief of Police. This detective shall also be responsible for presenting the case to the State Attorney's Office for their review.
 - k. Any member whose actions result in death or serious bodily injury shall be removed from the line of duty and placed on administrative leave pending a fit for duty evaluation.
 - l. The Chief of Police or his/her designee shall give final authorization for the officer involved to return to full duty.
 - m. A Mental Health Counselor should accompany the CID detective when making "Next of Kin" notifications.
 - n. A Mental Health Counselor shall follow up with the family of all individuals who are injured following the use of deadly force to determine the family's needs.
2. Class 2 - Intentional use of non-deadly force. Whether or not there is visible injury or whether or not a subject complains of injury:
- a. The officer shall, if necessary, immediately summon and render first aid. Immediately after the occurrence, the officer shall notify a supervisor of such use of force as defined in Policy 119.1 C. 11.
 - b. When the supervisor is notified they shall ascertain what occurred, ensure medical aid is provided to all injured persons and determine if further investigation is necessary. If the supervisor determines further investigation is necessary, the supervisor shall:
 - (1). Respond to the scene to further the investigation.

- (a). Unless the scene requires expediting the removal of the subject from the scene, the member and supervisor shall meet at a safe location as near the scene as practical.
 - (2). Examine the injured.
 - (3). Attempt to identify witnesses and ensure their information is documented in the offense report.
 - (4). Photograph all of the subject's and officer's injuries and areas of complaint of injury, regardless of visible or non-visible injuries.
- c. The supervisor shall respond to the scene under the following situations:
- (1). If requested by the arresting Officer.
 - (2). Injury requiring medical clearance.
 - (3). Complaint of Injury, whether visible or non-visible.
 - (4). Jail Refusal of admittance due to injury.
 - (5). BSO Medical advises FLPD of prisoner's complaint of injury.
- No Notice to Appear (NTA) shall be issued if any of the above applies, until a supervisor responds and approves the issuance of the NTA, in lieu of medical clearance. The supervisor will initial the corner of the NTA.
- d. The department member shall detail the response to resistance in an offense report and route a copy of the report to Internal Affairs.
- e. The responding supervisor shall review the offense report, ensure the response to resistance is explained in detail, confirm that a copy of the report is routed to Internal Affairs and all photographs are placed into evidence.

D. RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE REVIEW

The Internal Affairs Unit shall review all reports involving the response to resistance, discharges of firearms and actions of members that result in, or is alleged to result in, injury or death to another, to determine whether or not it is consistent with Department policies and professional law enforcement standards. The Internal Affairs Unit shall conduct an annual administrative review and analysis of such reports, and shall forward the report to the Chief of Police.

E. RECOMMENDATION FOR REMEDIAL TRAINING

Pursuant to any response to resistance, any reviewing Department supervisor may recommend appropriate remedial training for the indicated Department member.
