






## Why Wayfinding?

## SE 17<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor Mobility Study

- Meets solutions 1 & 2
- Signage on Andrews and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenues in future, undefined and unfunded phase

#### Wayfinding Signage

Key issues noted by neighbors & study team:

Current signage does not encourage drivers to take optimal routes to destinations

#### Solution:

- Better sign Andrews and 3rd as routes to Downtown and Las Olas
- Better sign SR 84 & Eller Drive as access to Port
- Better sign SE 10th Ave as access to Harbor Shops

## Sign Types for 17<sup>th</sup> Street

- 17<sup>th</sup> Street will only receive Vehicular Directional
- Up to 3 destinations per sign
- Signs to public, governmental, and non-profit areas only
  - Recreational areas
  - Districts (museum, shopping, etc.)
  - Parks lots, garages, and decks
  - Historical resources
  - Public Transit


