


Project Background

- 2019 Commission Annual Action Plan
- Las Olas Mobility Group established in June 2018
- Focal Areas:
 - Balance multi-modal needs
 - Improve and expand sidewalk conditions
 - Improve pedestrian safety crosswalks, lighting, ADA access, connectivity
 - Landscaping, shade, and infrastructure improvements

Project Area

- 2.5 miles long with six distinct character areas
- Boundaries include
 - North: Broward Blvd
 - East: Intercoastal Waterway
 - South: New River/Las Olas
 - West: Andrews Ave
- Includes Streets, Sidewalks, Right of Way, and Waterways






Project Scope
