225 SE 16th Avenue consists of two rectangularshaped buildings arranged in an L-shape around a central courtyard and pool. The two-story buildings have a stucco wall finish and a flat roof clad with membrane roofing. Character-defining elements include the concrete window eyebrows, incised horizontal line at roofline, corner windows, and floating staircase.

Windows: Aluminum frame awning, single-pane

sliding windows, glass block

Alterations: Window replacement and add balconies in 1962 - Courtney Stewart listed as architect; window and door replacement in 2004

1520 SE 2nd Court is a two-story Spanish Revival-style house. It has a stucco wall finish and a low-pitched hipped roof clad with terra-cotta barrel tile roofing. Character-defining elements include the concrete overhang above the main entry and on the second floor porch landing, recessed simple door surround, simple box form, and glass block windows.

1612 SE 2nd Street is a one-story, Art Moderne style single family house. It has a stucco wall finish and a flat roof clad with membrane roofing. Character-defining elements include the roofline coping, flush corner windows, concrete window eyebrows, rounded corners, and glass-block windows.

The house was designed and built by R. T. Hodges for his own personal house. Hodges moved to Fort Lauderdale in 1924 and owned and operated Hodges & Sons Real Estate.¹

Windows: Four-pane casement, glass block Alterations: Addition to living room including porch, bath, and storage in 1948

1521 SE 2nd Court is a roughly rectangular-plan, two-story Mission-style apartment building. It has a rough stucco wall finish and a flat roof clad with membrane roofing. Character-defining elements include the stepped parapet, textured stucco cladding, decorative terra-cotta cartouche, and three-over-one windows.
