## **UTILITY / AGENCY OWNER (UAO) REGISTRATION GUIDE**

**PURPOSE**: City providing for registration of communications facility and services providers as well as pass through providers for the City of Fort Lauderdale communications facilities in the public rights-of-way per <u>City Ordinance C-17-03</u> and <u>https://laws.flrules.org/2019/131</u>

### **REGISTRATION PROCESS:**

- 1. Utility Agency Owner (UAO) Registrants shall combine all required information into one (1) Adobe PDF file.
- 2. Registrants shall email the PDF file. To Email click the following email link: DSDEngineeringAdmin@fortlauderdale.gov
  - a. Email subject line shall include (one choice below):
    - i. "UAO New Registration" first time registrant
    - ii. **or** "UAO Renewal Registration" renew a minimum of 10 days prior to expiration date.

### 3. **REGISTRATION FORMS:**

- **a.** (Gas, Electric, Fiber/Telecommunications user)
  - i. Click → <u>Franchise Utility ROW User Registration Form</u>
- **b.** (Small Cell/5G Technology user)
  - i. Click → Communications Facility ROW User Registration Form

#### 4. NOTES:

- a. Certificate of Insurance (COI) shall meet all requirements of <u>City Ordinance</u>
  25-113 . <u>Certificate Holder and Additional Insured</u>: City of Fort Lauderdale 101
  NE 3rd Avenue, Suite 2100, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301. <u>Provide updated COI annually</u>, prior to expiration.
- **b.** If any Registration information changes during the 5 year registration period, it is the responsibility of Registrant to provide this information to DSD Engineering staff.
- c. If UAO utilizes any contractors, their Contractors (EC/GC)\* shall be registered with the City and shall be up to date. GC/EC Registration Found online here> LauderBuild FAQ | City of Fort Lauderdale, FL
