City Commission Adopts New City Commission District Map

The City Commission passed an ordinance on second reading adopting a new City Commission district map that will go into effect ten days from the City Commission meeting on April 27, 2022. The new map was developed by redistricting consultants from Florida Atlantic University's (FAU) Florida Institute of Government in response to the need to reestablish Fort Lauderdale's Commission district boundaries to ensure population equity based on 2020 U.S. Census data.
