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It's easy to register or renew association recognition with the City of Fort Lauderdale. Simply follow these steps:

- Complete the online application at www.fortlauderdale.gov before March 1 each year.
- Provide a copy of the association's minutes.
- Maintain a set of association bylaws.
- Hold a general election for the board/leadership team every two years.
- Be in good standing with the City of Fort Lauderdale.
