
Tortuga Music Festival Study

Visitors

Tortuga Music Festival is a three-day annual music festival attracting thousands of visitors to Fort Lauderdale Beach every year. The City of Fort Lauderdale's Nighttime Economy Office used foot traffic data to illustrate the impact the Tortuga Music Festiva has on the area.



Number of visitors to Tortuga Beach Festival 2019-2023



The festival started in 2013 and typically takes place in April. The 2020 festival was rescheduled to November 2021 due to the pandemic and consequent lockdowns. The 2022 event shows above prepandemic attendees, with a drop in visitors in 2023. A reason for that may be the inclement weather Fort Lauderdale experienced in the week leading up to the 2023 event with historic rainfall and flooding. The festival area was evacuated for a few hours on the opening day due to severe weather warnings.

Where do the visitors come from in the US?


Foot traffic data shows that the Tortuga Festival primarily attracts its audience regionally. In 2023, 68% of the visitors live in Florida, followed by New York State at a distance second with 3%. Within Florida, the majority of the visitors live in Broward and the tri-county area.


Heatmap of Tortuga visitors' home locations in Florida.





Visit Trends

The following chart illustrates the weekly visits to the City of Fort Lauderdale, the Beach Business Improvement District (the boundary runs along State Road A1A between Sunrise Boulevard to the north and the east/west portion of Holiday Drive to the south), and the direct beach festival area between January 1, 2022, and April 29, 2023. The number of visits is higher than the number of visitors, as the number of visits includes repeat visits from the same visitor. The number of visits to the Tortuga Beach Festival in 2023 over the three days was 168,900 as 75,400 visitors left and returned 2.24 times.



The festival has a significant impact on the local beach businesses and hospitality industry as illustrated by the following two charts. The following graph illustrates the number of daily visits to the Beach Business Improvement District in 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.



The top 10 most visited locations by the festival goers are in the beach area.


