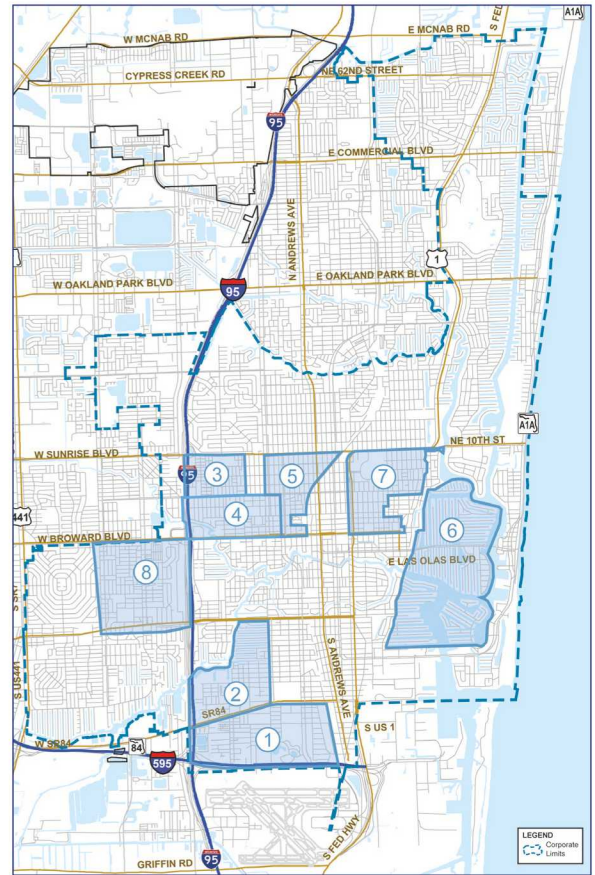


In 2016, the City of Fort Lauderdale embarked on an ambitious Stormwater/Resilience Master Plan.

The Program began with significant data collection, modeling, planning, and permitting, with a focus on eight initial, highly flood-prone neighborhoods. That work led into detailed design, permitting, and construction within those neighborhoods. This effort also included modification of the City's Stormwater Utility Rate Structure and securing of bond funding. The eight neighborhoods and their respective project status are shown below.

Neighborhood	Project Status
1a Edgewood	Construction substantially complete
1b Osceola Creek Dredging (Edgewood)	Construction 40% complete
2a River Oaks (Underground Utilities)	Construction substantially complete
2b River Oaks (Pump Stations)	In Construction
3 Durrs	Bids opened 11/9/2023
4 Dorsey-Riverbend	Bids opened 1/19/2024
5 Progresso Village	Design being updated; Bidding Third Quarter 2024
6 Southeast Isles	Design being updated; Bidding Third Quarter 2025
7 Victoria Park	Design being updated; Bidding First Quarter 2025
8 Melrose Manors/ Riverland Civic	In Design; estimated completion of design in Fall 2025



In addition, numerous City-owned seawalls have or are being replaced/elevated to protect against tidal flooding. Completed to-date are Isle of Palms, Cordova Road, and Hendricks Isle. Under construction are SE 10th Street, Merle Fogg Park, and several along Las Olas Boulevard.

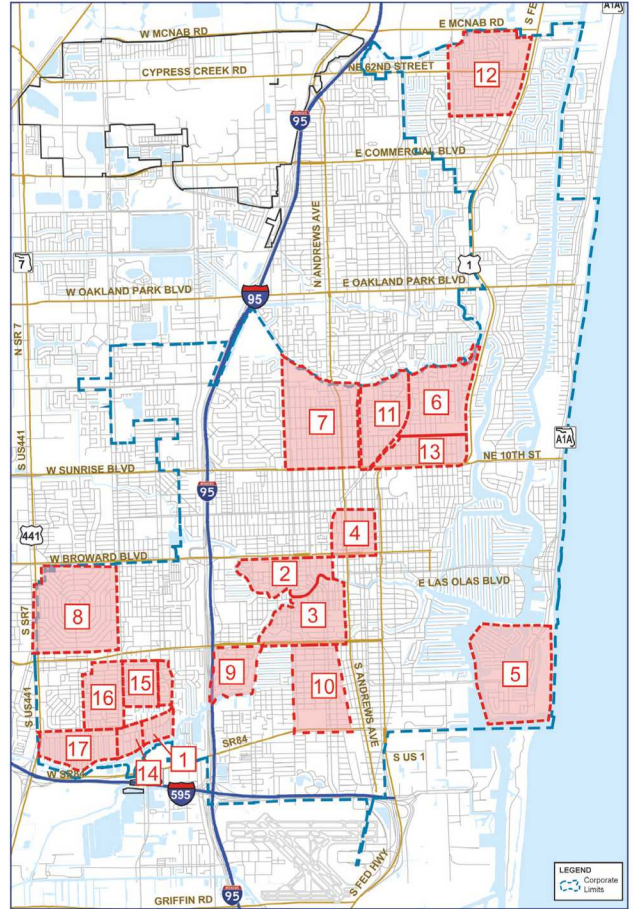
Fort Lauderdale Stormwater Program January 2024

At the 2023 State of the City Address, the Mayor unveiled plans for the next phase of this Program, which will include 17 additional neighborhoods.

Work was initiated in January 2024 and will include updates to the City-wide Stormwater Model, conceptual planning for infrastructure investments in these new areas, and significant public outreach (including an element focused on "Private Property Resilience"). Upon completion of this preliminary work in 2025, detailed design, permitting, and construction will proceed in a phased approach, with all neighborhoods anticipated to be complete by 2034.
