Public Works contract with vendor to assist with clearing of storm water

Melrose Park Stormwater Updates

Our Public Works team has engaged a vendor to inspect (CCTV) and clean all the catch basins, pipes, and structures to ensure they provide maximum drainage capacity. Although this is a very large neighborhood, and the total cost of this project will exceed \$4.7M, public works staff fast-tracked the project and it is in progress. Maintenance work will be completed within the next month. This is strictly maintenance of the existing system and not design construction of anything new, but we expect that the cleanup effort will improve drainage in the area.

BASS PARK IMPROVEMENTS



Safety is an important theme for my office. As a result, the district 3 office requested improvements to be made near Bass Park. This project is in the City of Fort Lauderdale on NW 18th Court between NW 26th Terrace and NW 28th Avenue. This project includes milling and resurfacing, landscaping, pavement markings, signage, and curbing near and adjacent to the renovated park. The road has been modified by tightening the road, adding parking on the north side with pavement markings, curbing and signing to restrict the two-way traffic on the corridor. Take a drive to Bass Park to check out the upgrades and enjoy open green spaces.

NW 16th AVENUE PAVING PROJECT



Earlier this year, I took a tour of the conditions of District 3 with the City Manager and staff. We noticed that there was an unpaved road that required paving. I am happy to report that the paving of NW 16th Ave between NW 7th Street and NW 8th Street was completed the week ending August 25, 2023. The work was completed as part of the Community Development Block Grant Program. We look forward to continuing to work and improve other roads and sidewalks in the area.
