I hope everyone is having a great week so far. Please see below for the official permit request details for "Project Conrad" (code name being used for the feature film we have been discussing this past week). Thank you for all of your time and patience and they have finalized the remaining details of this scene. Looping in Parks, Police, and TAM together since you have all been part of the initial steps of this process, but feel free to forward any others necessary.

I believe a majority of the information is consistent with what was described in their initial outreach. Attached you will find overhead diagrams of their car scene placement on A1A, as well as an overhead of the beach area where they will request to hold pedestrian traffic for safety during the stunt scene (which is a car spin out). Officers will be onsite from FLPD for the crowd control/traffic control. MOT plan is pending final approval from FDOT and TAM and they expect to have FDOT official approval come through shortly.

NOTE: They have also made an additional request regarding painting of a beach structure (see attached image) which we have confirmed is not City property, so they will be reaching out to the property ownership for approval, but just wanted to be sure you were all aware of the activity. If approved they will paint this structure pastel blue color on 2/25, film it on 2/26, and repaint to original color on 2/27.

As noted below, for any vehicles not involved in scene within road closure area, crew vehicles/production trucks are parking in private lots near location so no requests involving public city lots near park areas.

It is my understanding that traffic advisories have already gone out through City. The production company complied with the required neighborhood sign offs and many private businesses have been compensated for any losses. That information will be included in the final permit package as an addendum.
